

Reverie Saigon is Leading Hotels' first in Ho Chi Minh

The Reverie Saigon will open in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, on September 1.

The luxury property will be the city's first member of the Leading Hotels of the World collection and will offer 286 rooms and extended-stay apartments over 39 floors.

Each room will be individually furnished by Italian design houses.

The La Scala Grand Ballroom will feature a 19th-century Bechstein grand piano. There will also be a three-metre Baldi clock in the main lobby imbedded with crystals and 24-carat gold, commissioned by the hotel.

The property will boast the longest bar in Ho Chi Minh City, a fleet of luxury vehicles including a Rolls-Royce Phantom Dragon, and a spa and fitness centre with views of the Saigon River.

There will be five dining options, led by Italian executive chef Giovanni Parrella, with restaurants ranging from Cantonese to Italian.

venue, Café Cardinal, will seat diners on three levels, each with views of Saigon. The sixth-floor open kitchen will offer diners the chance to watch chef Sebastien

Schneider and his team at work.

Floors 19 to 26 will house the extended-stay apartments, comprising 78 one-bedroom units and 11 two-bedroom apartments. Guests will have access to a private fitness facility, as well as being free to use the main hotel's amenities.

Bed-and-breakfast rates range from £288 to £353 a night, including Wi-Fi and minibar. Suites range from £513 to £9,629 a night, including airport transfers. thereveriesaiigon.com
