The Reverie Saigon to Offer Yacht Day Trips



THE REVERIE YACHT has electronically controlled sun loungers, a spacious master bedroom and a built-in outdoor barbecue.

After acquiring a 60-foot Monte Carlo 6, **The Reverie Saigon** in Vietnam revealed it will begin offering day excursions along the Saigon River. The new options range from a two-and-a-half-hour sunset cruise to an eight-hour golf and picnic sailing. Sweet.

The shortest of the three cruising options, “Saigon Intermezzo,” departs in the late afternoon so that passengers can watch the city transition to nighttime. The excursion includes a champagne picnic with a bottle of Louis Roederer and five prix-fixe menus to choose from. Guests receive roundtrip transfers from the hotel in a Mercedes-Benz S-Class or a BMW 7 Series.

The five-hour “Saigon Avventura” offers a trip to the Can Gio UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, an

80,000-hectare reserve blanketed with a rich mangrove forest full of wildlife. It also includes all the elements from the Saigon Intermezzo sailing.

Lastly, “Saigon Spettacolare” includes a visit to Taekwang Jeongsan Country Club for a round of golf and the champagne picnic. Want to make it super special? Ask to arrange for full lunch and dinner service.

Bringing an entourage? The new yacht accommodates up to 10 guests comfortably. It operates with a crew of three and a private butler.

And, for those Instagrammable moments, there are plenty of chic settings. The yacht has electronically controlled sun loungers on the foredeck, a large master bedroom below deck and a built-in outdoor barbecue on the back deck.
